Supplier
Standard Terms and Conditions**

General:

As a Supplier to DG Precision, it is understood that your organization agrees to meet the following requirements for all purchase orders as applicable.

Our organization reserves the right of final approval of product, procedures, processes, and equipment. All special processes required by this Purchase Order must be performed by qualified personnel. Our organization reserves the right to review and approve the Supplier's Quality Management System.

Standard QMS Requirements may include:

- Supplier providing calibration services must provide evidence of calibration traceable to NIST or similar accreditation, when applicable.
- Supplier providing special processing must maintain a system for validating processes similar to that of a NADCAP program.
- Customer Directed sources must operate in accordance with approved specifications and standards as dictated and controlled by the customer in question.
- Supplier initially approved for use via Certification (ISO, AS9100, ISO 17025, AS9120, etc.) must notify our organization of any changes to that certification.
- The Supplier shall maintain the proper identification and revision status of specifications, drawings, process requirements, inspection/verification instructions and other relevant technical data.
- The Supplier must ensure that all materials used and/or finished products are in conformance with all specifications according to the Purchase Order and/or Customer Drawing.
- The Supplier is responsible for handling and packaging all parts in a manner that preserves product condition and eliminates Foreign Object Debris (FOD).

Our organization reserves the right to designate requirements for test specimens for design approval, inspection/verification, investigation or auditing.

The Supplier is required to:

- Notify our organization of nonconforming product.
- Obtain our organization's approval for nonconforming product disposition.
- Notify our organization of changes in product and/or process, changes of suppliers, and changes of manufacturing facility locations.
- Flow down to the supply chain the applicable requirements including customer requirements.
- Retain all Records associated with the Purchase Order as required by contract or a minimum of (25) twenty-five years.
- Provide the right of access by our organization, our customer and regulatory authorities to the applicable areas of all facilities, at any level of the supply chain, involved in the order and to all applicable records.
